- Place the emotional and physical well being of players at the top of your priorities (to include a safe playing environment.)
- Do not use tobacco, drugs, or alcohol while involved with BFB&G games, practices and/or related activities.

PARENTS & PLAYERS

- Present exemplary behavior during all games, practices, and/or related activities, remembering that all coaches, managers, and board members are volunteers.
- Display and encourage sportsmanship at all times.
- Do not use profanity at any time.
- Demonstrate respect to coaches, managers, umpires, and players.
- Do not use tobacco, drugs, or alcohol while involved with BFB&G games, practices and/or related activities.
- Help maintain a clean and safe playing environment.
